## **NEEDED: CONTRACT COMMUNITY CONNECTORS TO ASSIST WITH THE HEALTH AND HAPPINESS PROJECT**

Lake County Build a Generation is seeking community connectors to assist with the research phase of the Lake County Community Health and Happiness Project in September and October 2020. We are seeking applicants who have strong connections or lived experience with those who may otherwise be underrepresented in this process (specifically youth, senior, and Latinx community members). We will be hiring for 8 positions and will be accepting applications on a rolling basis until positions are filled.

### **ABOUT LAKE COUNTY BUILD A GENERATION AND THE HEALTH AND HAPPINESS PROJECT**

The Health and Happiness Project is a project designed to better understand and plan for the health needs of Lake County residents.

### **COMMUNITY CONNECTOR RESPONSIBILITIES AND TASK VALUES:**

- Attend an orientation and training regarding the Community Health and Happiness Project work (\$100).
- Support 25 individuals in target populations in completing the Lake County Health and Happiness Survey by the end of October. This will involve individual relationship-building as well as attendance at group events to have community members complete the survey either on their personal phone/computer or on an iPad provided by LCBAG (\$400).
- Conduct 3 regular check-ins with LCBAG staff to ensure the project is on track (\$225).
- Attend 2 Community Health and Happiness Project meetings in order to represent the views of community members (\$150).
- Attend 3 Community Health and Happiness Project Steering Committee meetings (\$225).
- Represent the Community Health and Happiness Project work and the views of the community in meetings with other stakeholders, as needed (\$20/hour on an as-needed basis).

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

- Must have strong connections in the community in Lake County and be able to identify at least 25 acquaintances in target populations to complete surveys.
- Must be positive, collaborative, and able to work well with a wide variety of community members.
- Must be able to commit to involvement in the project and completion of work from September-November, and be able to complete surveys in September and October.
- Must have access to the internet and the ability to use an online survey and online meeting program.

### **COMPENSATION**

Community Connectors will work on a contract basis and **will not be** employees of Lake County Build a Generation. Community Connectors will be paid with a stipend for completing the tasks listed above. Community Connectors will earn **up to** \$1100 for completing the above tasks, and can earn an additional \$20/hour for additional work (this will be mutually agreed upon by LCBAG and community connector.) Community connectors will be paid monthly, based on completed tasks submission of invoices (template available from LCBAG if needed) indicating that you have completed them. While we understand that occasionally a task may not be completed (for example, you may be unable to attend a meeting), community connectors should be prepared to complete the majority—and preferably all—of the listed tasks.

Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis and will be considered until August 31st or until all positions are filled.
